Applications to the UU Executive Board must be submitted by a Utrecht University researcher and must be within one of the 15 UU research focus areas and linked to one of the 4 strategic themes of Utrecht University ('Life Sciences', 'Sustainability', 'Institutions', 'Youth and Identity')
