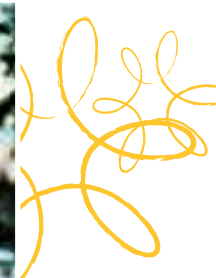
HELSINKI SUMMER SCHOOL is a three-week academic event organised every August by the University of Helsinki, Aalto University and Hanken School of Economics.
