“Silk Roads” is an association registered under French law, which initiates a two-week exchange alternatively in both countries every year. It is organized by students for students. The exchange was first started on February 2005 in France, as the return in October 2005 in China. The main goal of the exchanges is to enable students to discover both industrial worlds and running of future partnerships.

The Chinese students involved in this program have been selected among students from the best Chinese Universities, including Tsinghua University, Peking University, Fudan University, Tongji University, Nanjing University, Southeast University and Nanjing Agricultural University. These universities are partners of ParisTech. The French students belong to engineering schools from this network, including the Ecole Polytechnique, the Ecole des Mines de Paris, the Ecole des Ponts et Chaussées, Télécom Paris and the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Arts et Métiers.

Privileges:

A two-week visit to France around Feb 2014, focusing on industrial and cultural aspect. Most part of the fee will be covered by French side, including meals, accommodation (home stay in French family), transportation and part of air tickets.

Responsibilities:

1. Organize Chinese session for French members during their stay in Shanghai.
2. Do market research and technical report assigned by French companies.
3. Organize workshop or campus talk for Chinese companies.
4. Establish the relationship with companies, manage the partnership and raise the sponsorship.
5. Build connections between current members and Silkroads Alumni.

Requirements:

1. Students with engineering/science background
2. Fluent both in English and Chinese (French is preferred).
3. Demonstrated leadership capability and teamwork skill.
4. High intellectual curiosity, energy and personal integrity.
5. Passionate in exploring Chinese and French culture and industry.
6. Students with good academic performance are preferred.
7. Students with experience in students' organization or internship in companies are preferred.
